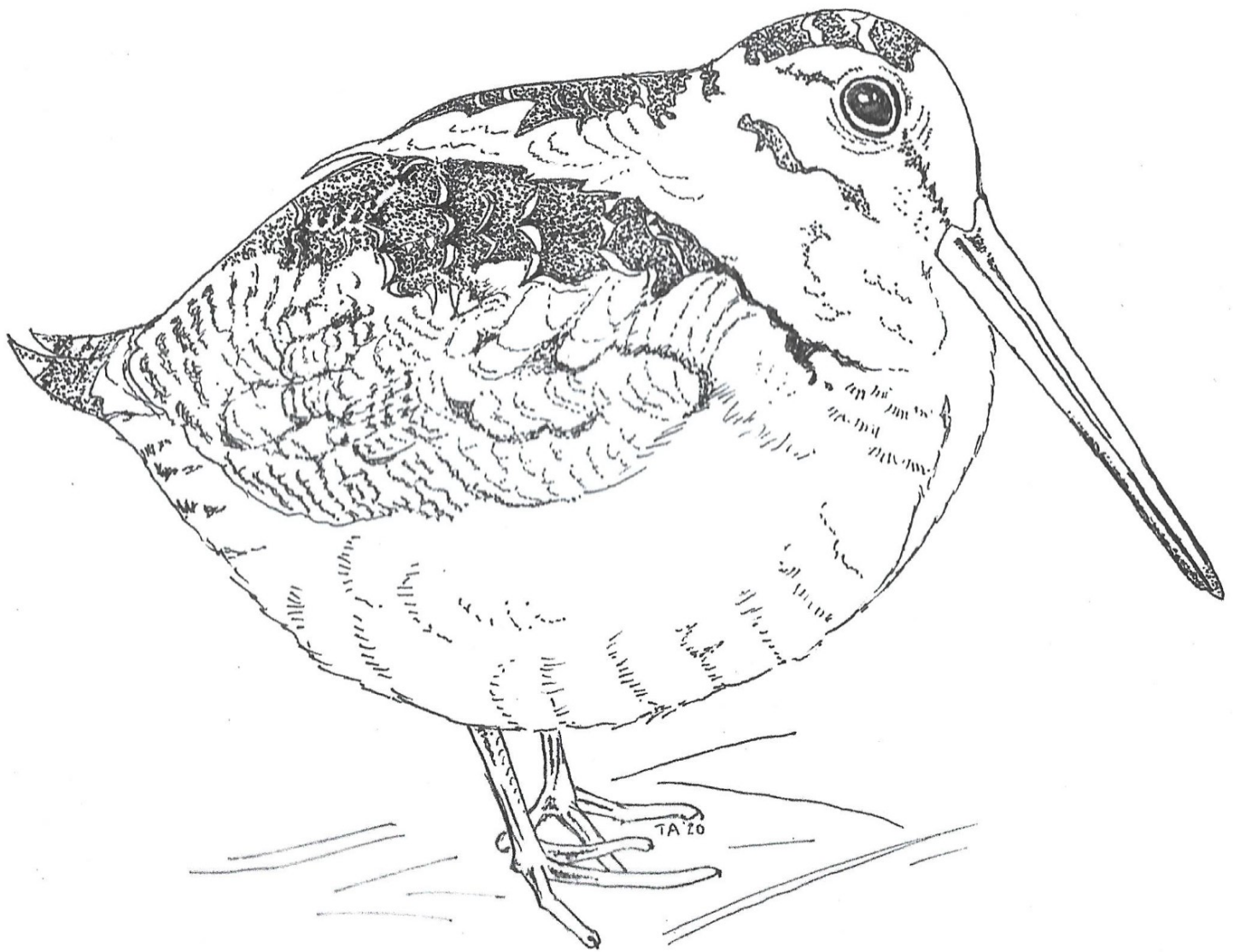




## Colour me! Timberdoodle



**Did you know?** The Timberdoodle is also known as the American woodcock. This fascinating bird helps herald the arrival of spring in the Grand River watershed. The male advertises for a mate by making a nasal “peent” sound from the ground. Then suddenly he flies upward in a widening spiral with wings whistling as he goes. He chirps back down to the ground, often returning to the same location where he started his amazing “sky dance”.
